

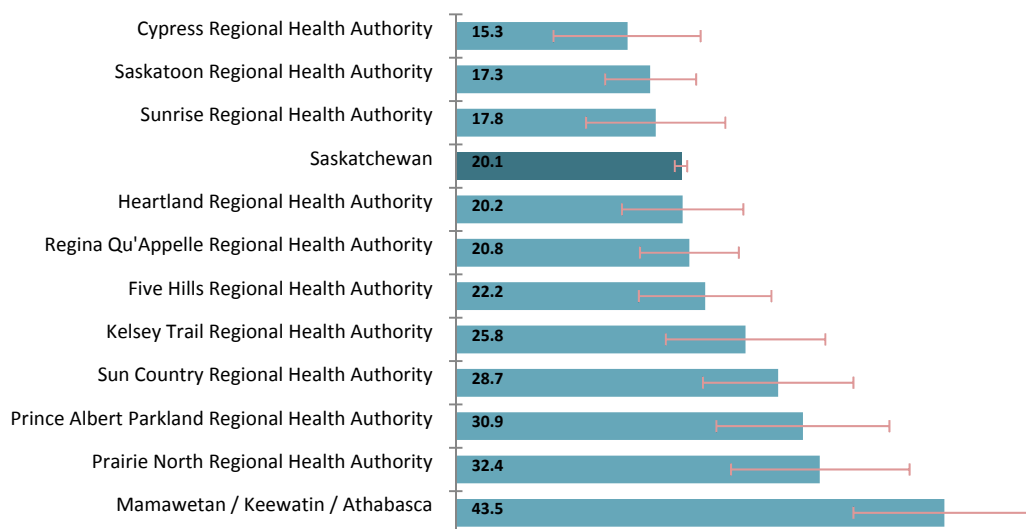

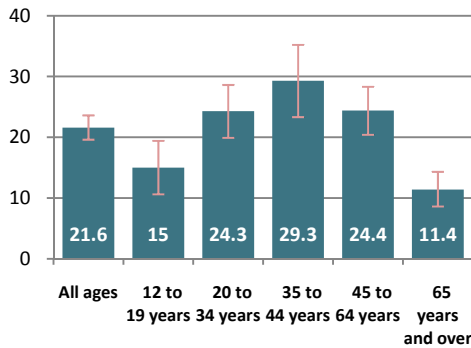
Smoking prevalence by health unit, Saskatchewan daily or occasional smoking, 2009



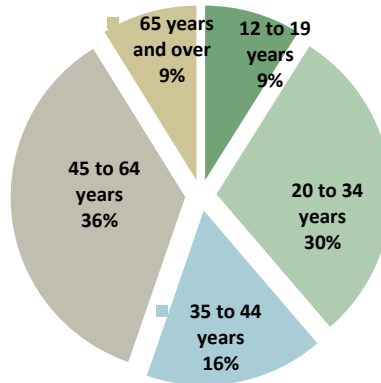

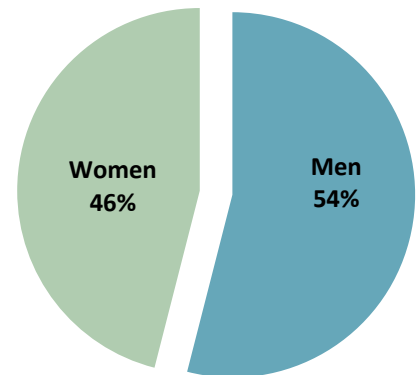
Prevalence of smoking by age Saskatchewan, 2009

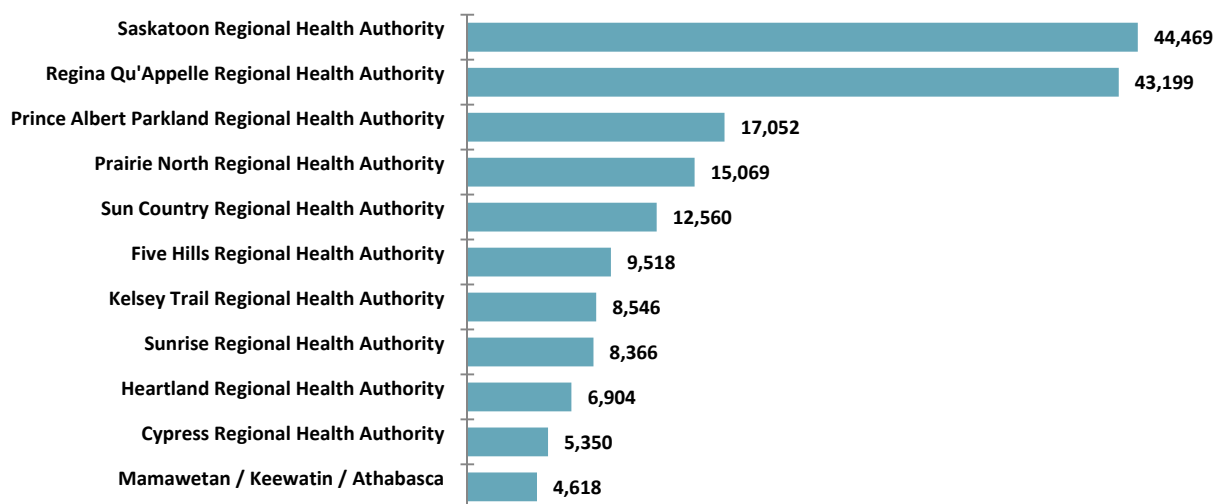

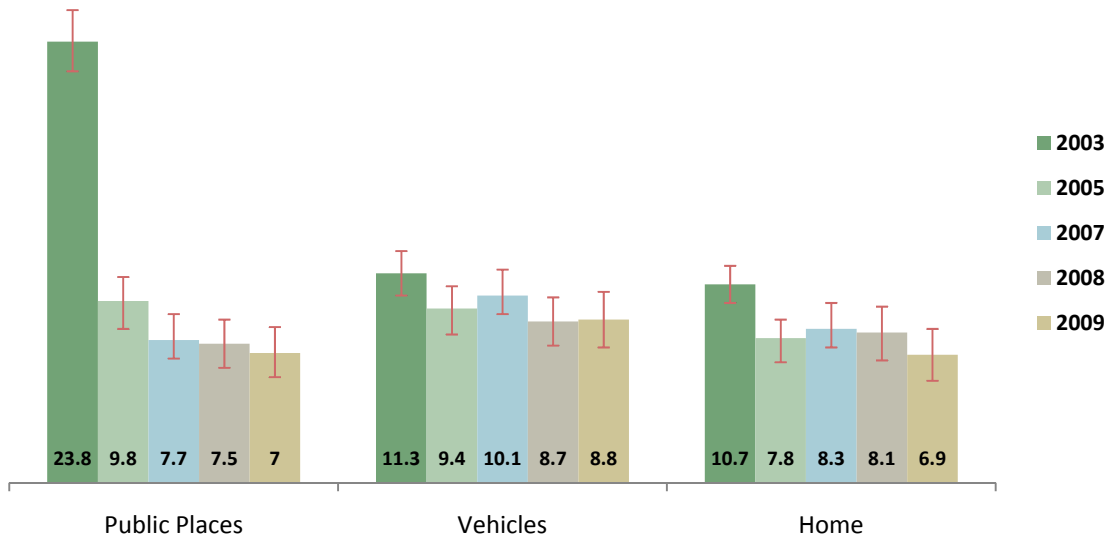

The questions used on the CCHS survey included:

- “At the present time, do you smoke cigarettes daily, occasionally or not at all?” This question was asked of all respondents.
- “Including both household members and regular visitors, does anyone smoke inside your home every day or almost every day?” This question was asked of non-smokers.
- (In the past month,) were you exposed to second-hand smoke, every day or almost every day, in public places (such as bars, restaurants, shopping malls, arenas, bingo halls, bowling alleys)? This question was asked of non-smokers.
- In the past month, were you exposed to second-hand smoke, every day or almost every day, in a car or other private vehicle? This question was asked of non-smokers.
